May: Moher's Day, Graduations & Memorial Day

The month of May is a time to honor mothers, congratulate graduates and remember those have passed into eternity.

This year, as war has again impacted our world, I would like to especially recognize those who have died serving our nation in conflicts throughout the world as we look forward to Memorial Day.

Clara and I have had the privilege to visit Arlington National Cemetery and observe the impressive vigilance at the tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Three casualties of war are buried there representing World War I, World War II and the Korean Conflict. There is a single rectangular block of marble designed with striking simplicity and on it the inscription, HERE RESTS IN HONORED GLORY AN AMERICAN SOLDIER KNOWN ONLY TO GOD.

"All three of these fallen heroes were selected outside the Continental United States to be buried in that tomb." *

But what touched my heart is that there is a green zone in the cemetery that has no bodies buried and is set aside to remember those lost in battle and

unaccounted for.

As says the inscription on the tomb of the unknown soldier, "Known Only To God," I was reminded of what is recorded in Matthew 10:29-32 as Jesus spoke, "Are not two sparrows sold for a cent? And yet not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Therefore, do not fear; you are of more value than many sparrows. Everyone therefore who shall confess Me Before men, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven."
