My hope is to offer a unique (to us) worship format at a time that might be more conducive for some people's schedules. Perhaps some from the church will enjoy coming both on Sunday morning, as well as Sunday evening.

Once these new programs are up and running, I hope to be able to have the time to possibly launch even more community based outreach events in our area. Some might be thinking slow down pastor, why the rush? Well as I look out at the area we live in, I am reminded of a farmer that looks at a field full of ripe wheat that is literally ready to fall down and be destroyed if a strong wind or rain were to blow. In fact Jesus said it best in John 4:35b, "Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest."
